FLOWERS FOR EASTER

If you would like to make a contribution towards the purchase of extra flowers to decorate our church at this special time of the year, please drop it into the office or put it in an envelope labelled 'flowers' and drop it into the offertory boxes.

Also, we are planning on having a cross at the lychgate for people to add flowers into as they arrive for church on Easter Sunday, we would love you to bring small sprigs of spring flowers and push them into the cross as you come into church.

ELECTORAL ROLL

Every year we are required to revise the electoral roll ahead of the APCM. You will find a copy of the current electoral roll at the back of church for you to check if you are currently enrolled. If you are not on the electoral roll and would like to be included you need to meet the following criteria:

- Be a member of the church of England and be resident in the parish
- Be a member of the Church of England, not resident in the parish but has habitually attended worship in the parish for the preceding 6 months.
- Be a member of a church not in communion with the Church of England but subscribes to the doctrines of the Holy Trinity and has habitually attended worship in the parish for the preceding 6 months.

You also need to be baptised and over the age of 16 (or 16 within the next 6 months).
