


DRAW IT

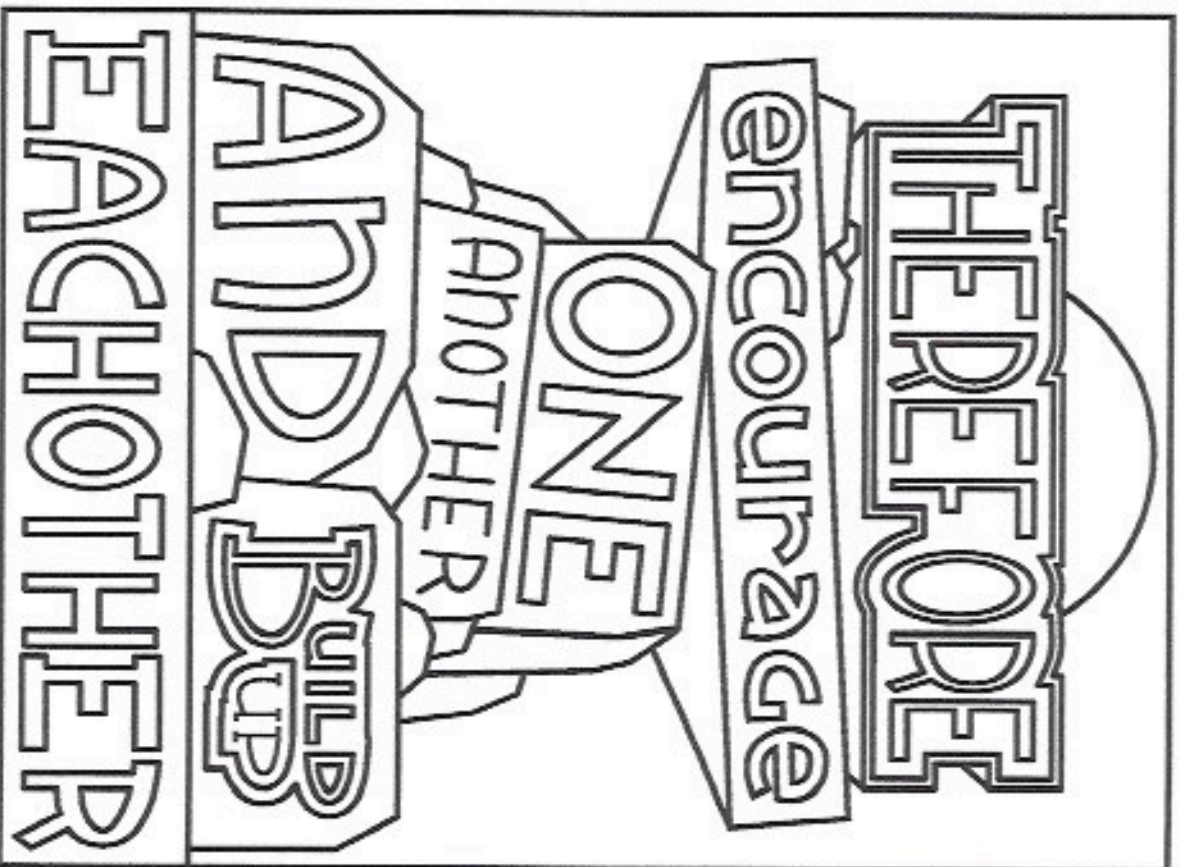

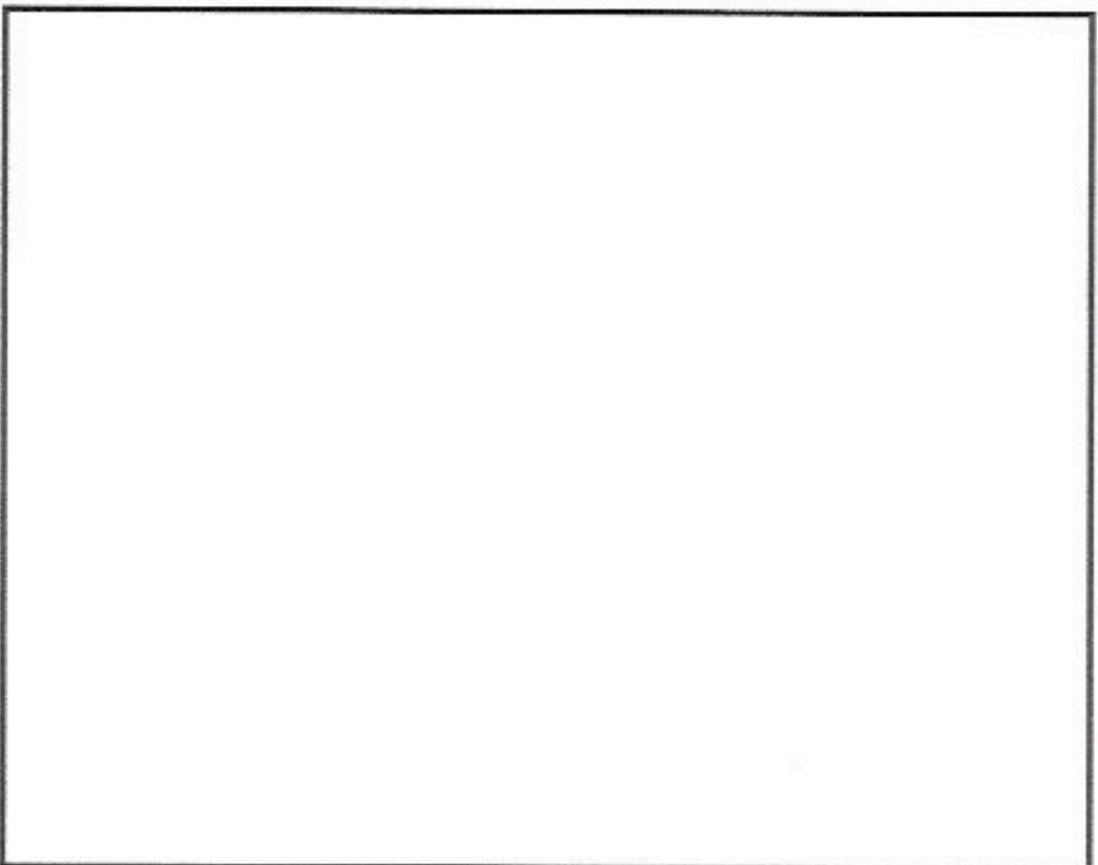
Activities based on Judges 4:17, 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11, Matthew 25:14-30.
