and I love you more.

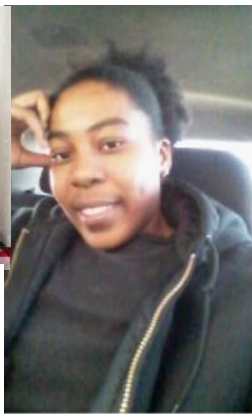
There is ink loving on the quill
