me; God wanted me now, He set me Free.

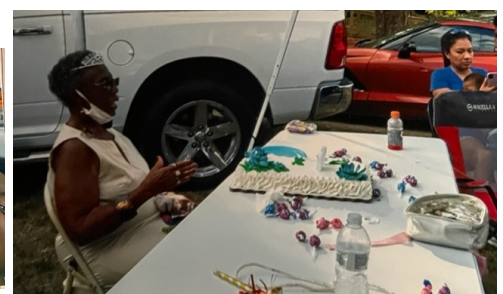


To my Aunt

She was a member of the Senior Choir and served as Secretary for over Twenty-eight years. During her early years there she organized Christmas and Easter Programs.
