Remembering the life of...

Matthew Hauge, 30, of Fergus Falls, passed away peacefully at the Sanford Medical Center in Fargo, North Dakota on Thursday, March 21, 2024.

He was born on February 11, 1994, to loving parents Cindy (Hill) and Mark Hauge in Dickinson, North Dakota. He was baptized at Rainbow Valley Lutheran Church near Ray, North Dakota. He was confirmed at Bethlehem Lutheran Church in Fergus Falls, Minnesota. Matthew graduated from Fergus Falls High School in 2012, where he loved participating in Track and Field, as well as Robotics.
