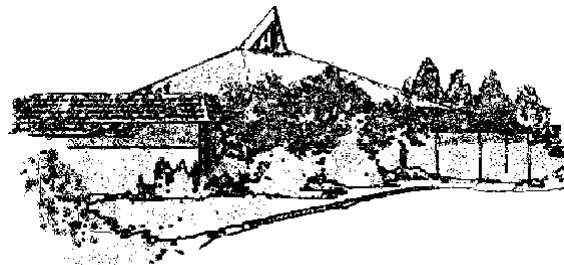
Church Needs
