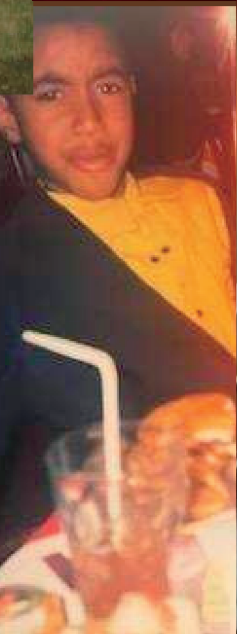

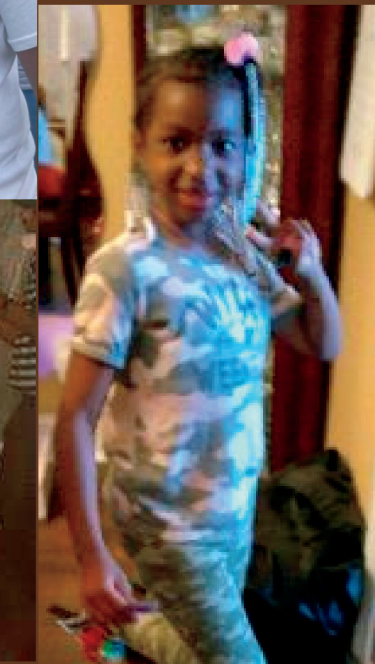
I will always be inspired by his spirit to live life on his own terms, despite opinions, it takes a lot of courage to do that. There are lessons in all things and everyone has something to teach.
