Hearing Impaired: New hearing devices are now available for those with hearing difficulties; please see the technician at the sound booth to give these new devices a try.

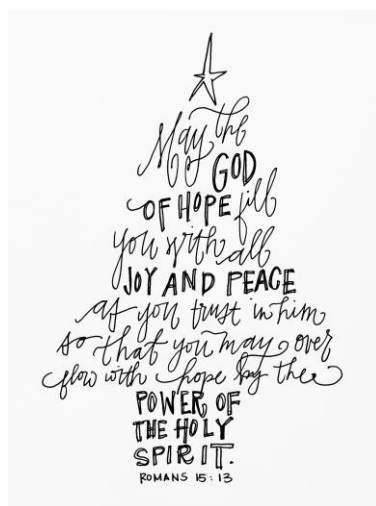
