Dion Henry is the pastor of the Beacon Light Seventh-day Adventist Church in Kansas City, Missouri. recently pastored the Salem Seventh-day Adventist Church in Pompano Beach, Florida. He has earned a Bachelor's degree in Theology from Oakwood University in Huntsville, Alabama. He received a Master's of Divinity degree as well as a Doctor of Ministry Degree (with emphasis in the family) from Andrews University in Berrien Springs, Michigan.
