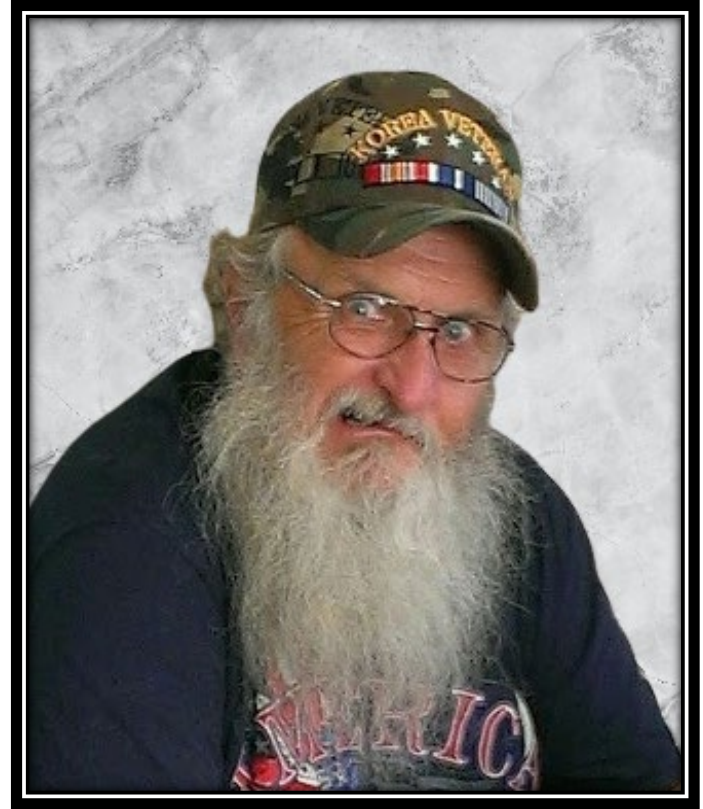


OBITUARY
