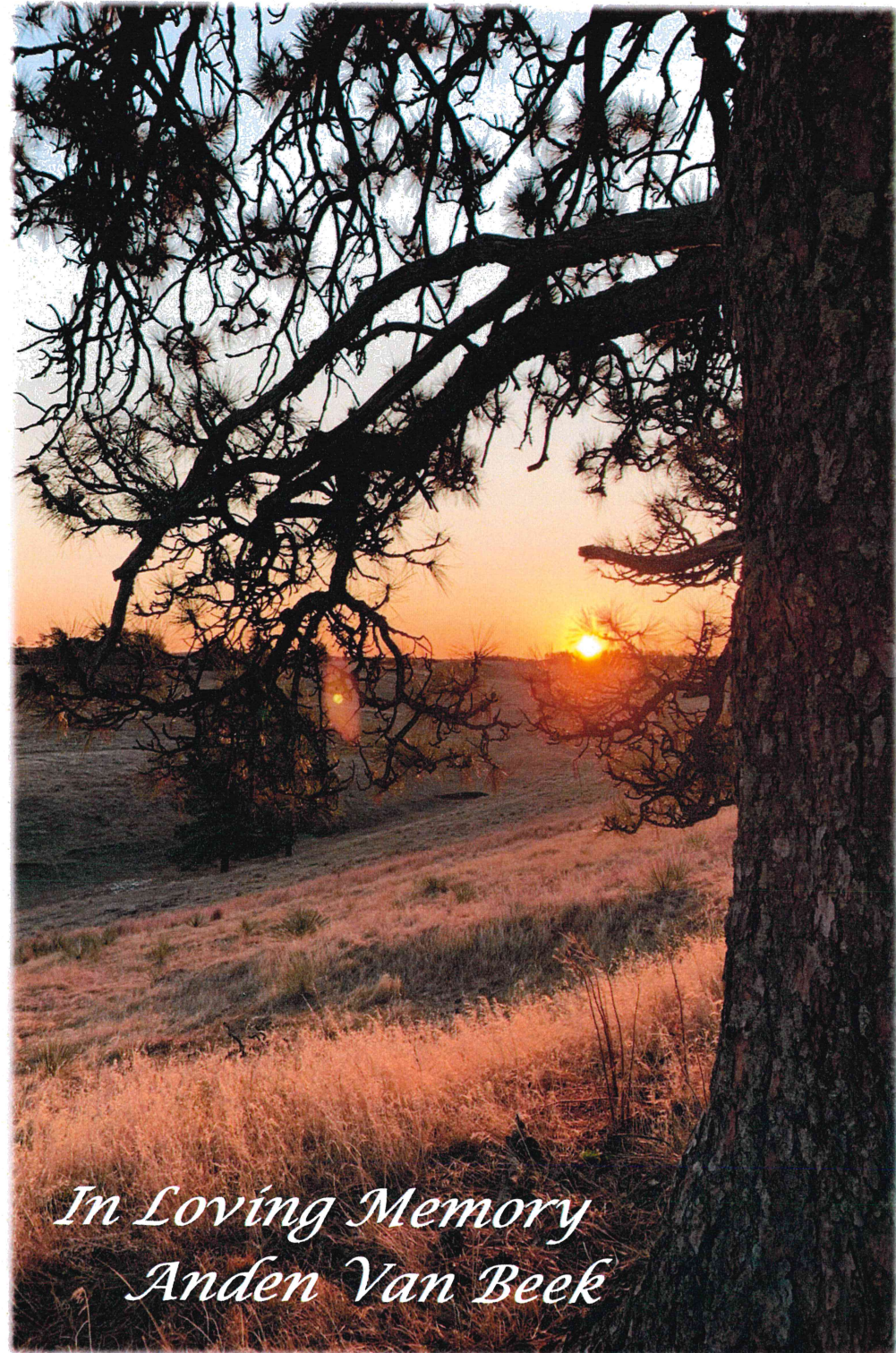
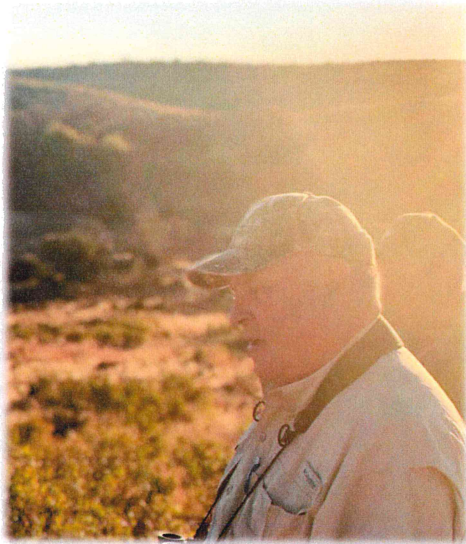


Psalm 100

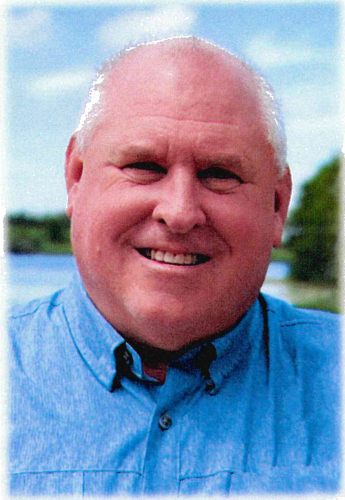
*Make a joyful noise unto the Lord,
