

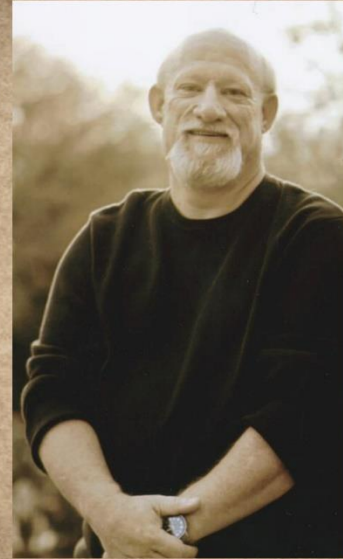
OBITUARY
