

Robert Lloyd Linnett was born on July 8, 1934 to Nis and Ailsa (Tromanhauser) Linnett in Diamond Lake Township, Minnesota. He was raised in Lincoln County and graduated from high school. As a child, he enjoyed riding his mini-bike and watching the crane on Lake Benton. In May 2023, Robert became a resident at Sunrise Manor Nursing Home in Tyler, where on Monday, October 2, 2023, he died peacefully at the age of 89 years, two months and 25 days.

Robert was a member of Tyler Alliance Church. He enjoyed collecting toy trucks and taking boat rides on Lake Benton. He also enjoyed shoveling snow and riding his bike, but not at the same time. He was a man of few words, but always very generous through his actions.
