

Alta Mae Groeneweg was born April 18, 1931, in Long Island, Kansas to Henry and Christina (Vander Plas) Kats. As a child, Alta and her family moved to Rock Valley, Iowa and she graduated from Western Christian High School in Hull, Iowa. On October 14, 1953, she married Walter Groeneweg and together they made their home northeast of Rock Valley where Alta stayed home to raise their 4

children. During those years she did a lot of gardening which yielded a bountiful fruit cellar. She also did a lot of sewing and crocheting and enjoyed reading, puzzles, and was still crocheting scarves for the orphan train until quite recently.

Alta served for many years for Hope Haven first as an apartment trainer and for Hope Haven Int'l wheelchair ministries. She traveled abroad to Vietnam, Guatemala, and Romania to help distribute them. She also volunteered at Love INC. Alta passed away Wednesday, October 9, 2024, at Whispering Heights in Rock Valley at the age of 93.
