Speak, he is list'ning.

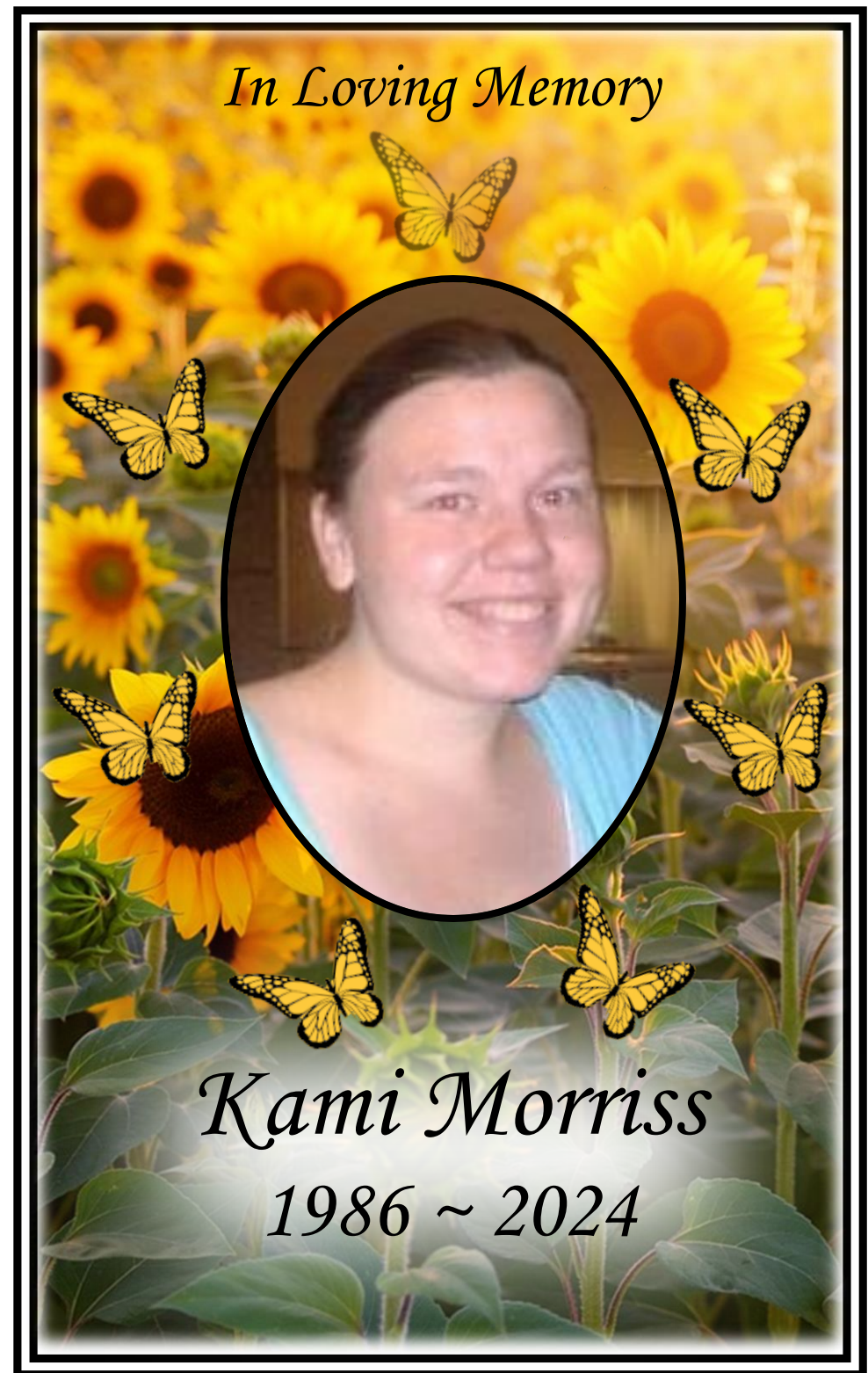
You are his child;
