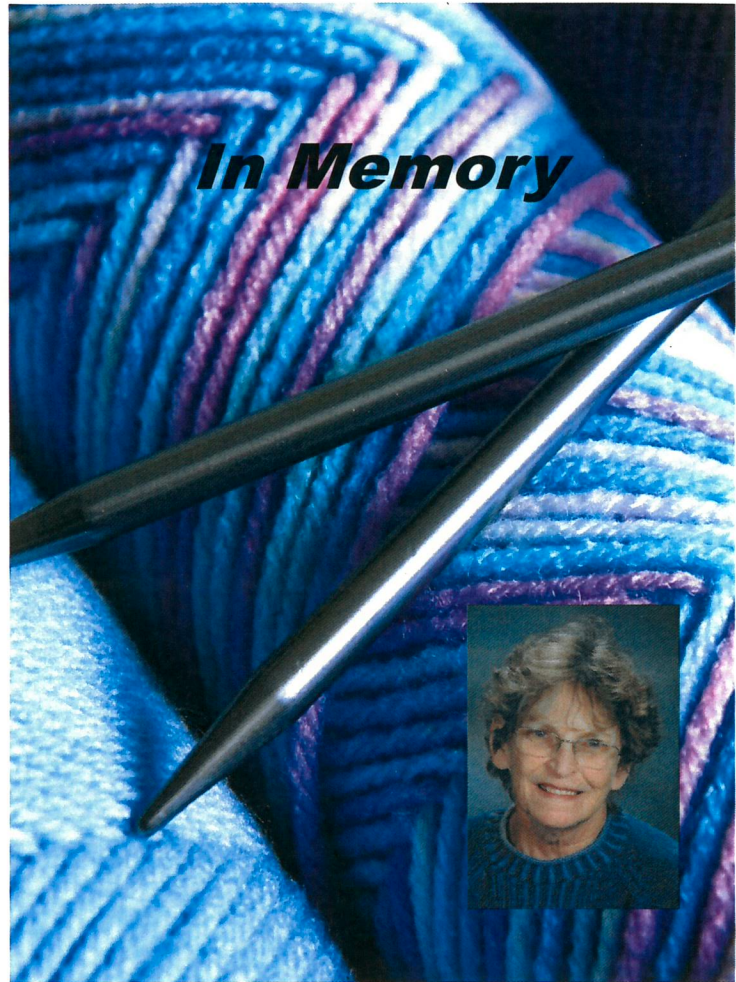


In Memory
