

Carderock Springs Citizen Association
Minutes – August 19, 2019

Board attending: Jack Orrick, Ashish Goel, Sue Eastman Tom Deyo; quorum present

Meeting called to order at 7:35

Minutes for June 24, 2019 approved without comment.

Treasurer Report

- Dues received from 307 households. This is 54% of all households who were sent notices and a 15% increase in the number of paid households over 2018.
- Investments have been made into CDs and are earning higher interest for year.

New Member material

- Material packets have been prepared and are ready for newcomer households.
- October 6 is the date for the next Newcomers Reception. All members of Carderock Springs are invited to attend and welcome the new families to Carderock.

Magnets

- Carderock Springs logo magnets have been produced and will be made available to all households and provided along with September newsletters. If a household wants another magnet they can be purchased for \$5. The website will provide a payment method for those that wish to purchase. CSCA will increase the pay this one time to those that deliver the newsletter to cover distribution of the magnets.

Fenway Road / Congressional

- Congressional received approval on July 18, 2019 from the Montgomery County Planning for its plans to make changes to the golf course and the drainage and stormwater retention plan. The submission will be placed on the chat for Carderock Springs residents.
- There was a public hearing which was noticed to Carderock residents via Chat.
- Fenway residents will lose water for one night when County repairs the water main. This will happen overnight to minimize the disturbance.

Pepco

- Office of People Counsel took up Carderock Springs' issue with Pepco on the power surge that has impacted several homes. The OPC has hired a consultant who is an expert in power distribution and they will be conducting a review and preparing a report for OPC. OPC is paying for this report.

Street Light Repair

- A list of problem street lights had been prepared and sent to County. The lights on the list have been fixed. If anyone has an issue with street lights then they should submit to the Montgomery County party identified on the chat.

Beltway

- A letter was sent to SHA from CSCA in June. The SHA contacted CSCA when it noted that the community was listed on the national historic register and invited a representative

of CSCA to meet with SHA regarding impact of the expansion on the historic designation.
This is being arranged.

Quite Skies

- The implementation of the GPS landing plan has been delayed by FAA.

Adat Shalom

- The synagogue still plans for members to park on Carderock Streets during the high holidays. They are making signs to inform members to park only on one side of the street. They are also informing members and training the police officers on this parking strategy.
