

"God's Garden"

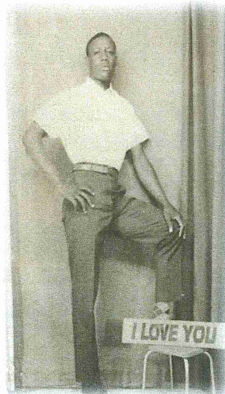
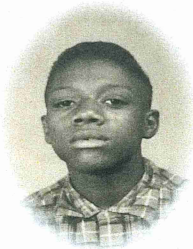
God looked around his garden and found an empty place, He then looked down upon the earth and saw your tired face

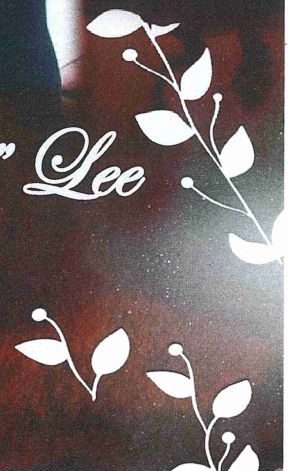

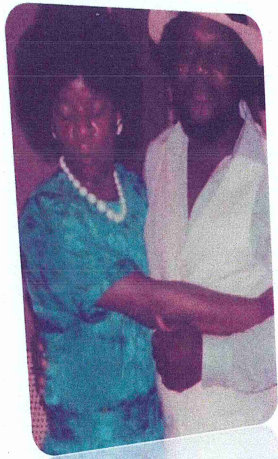
Obituary
