WITH I BEAUTIFUL DAUGHTER THEN 5 ACTIVE SONS, THEY MASTERED THE ART OF RAISING UPSTANDING MEN. THEY CELEBRATED THEIR 50TH ANNIVERSARY IN 2007. MARCIA LOVED HER FAMILY DEEPLY AND WAS AN EXCELLENT MOTHER, GRANDMOTHER AND A GREAT GRANDMOTHER.

MARCIA WAS MANY THINGS TO MANY PEOPLE. SHE WAS A MOTHER, SISTER, WIFE, DAUGHTER OF UTAH PIONEERS, AWARD WINNING COOK, NEIGHBOR, ARTIST, TEACHER, TRAVELER, HERO TO MANY AND ALWAYS A GOOD FRIEND TO EVERYONE.
