Important Notes about testing --

There are 2 types of Covid-19 Tests:

1. Antigen (“Rapid test”) – nasal or throat swab. Results come back quickly.
2. Molecular (PCR test) – nasal, throat or saliva sample. Results may take up to 5 days.

The Montgomery County Health Department will **not** allow schools to accept a negative Antigen (Rapid) Test to return to school. You must wait for the PCR. Please make sure a PCR is being done when you have the sample collected.
