Message of Encouragement: Kendra Carlson

Have you ever tried to think your way out of a feeling? I remember feeling afraid at night as a child. I'd tell myself how safe I was and I didn't have any reason to feel the way I was feeling. I'd argue with my feelings, but I'd still feel scared. When I had babies and felt sad, I scolded myself for being ungrateful. My dream had come true. How could I be unhappy NOW? It just wasn't *appropriate*.

What I've learned since is, rejecting our feelings doesn't work. You can't talk your way out of a feeling or win a debate against it. Feelings are information our body sends to let us know something is happening in us. Some of the most unpleasant feelings are life-saving smoke signals. Susan David gave a TED talk about how we classify feelings as good or bad and expect people to stop having or expressing the "bad" ones. She calls it a tyranny of positivity. The tragedy of rejecting uncomfortable emotions is, they get stronger. Like a child who hurt themselves and didn't get a response when they first cried out, they look around and work up a louder cry. Feelings need to be acknowledged and learned from and only then, will they will naturally move on.

Jesus promised to replace our unfeeling, stone hearts, with hearts of flesh in Eze. 36:26. I'm grateful to know our feelings are gifts to *help* us, even ones that feel terrible. There's no need to argue them down. Jesus will help us name them and let them teach us what we need to know.
