Resp.: And You shall renew the face of the earth.

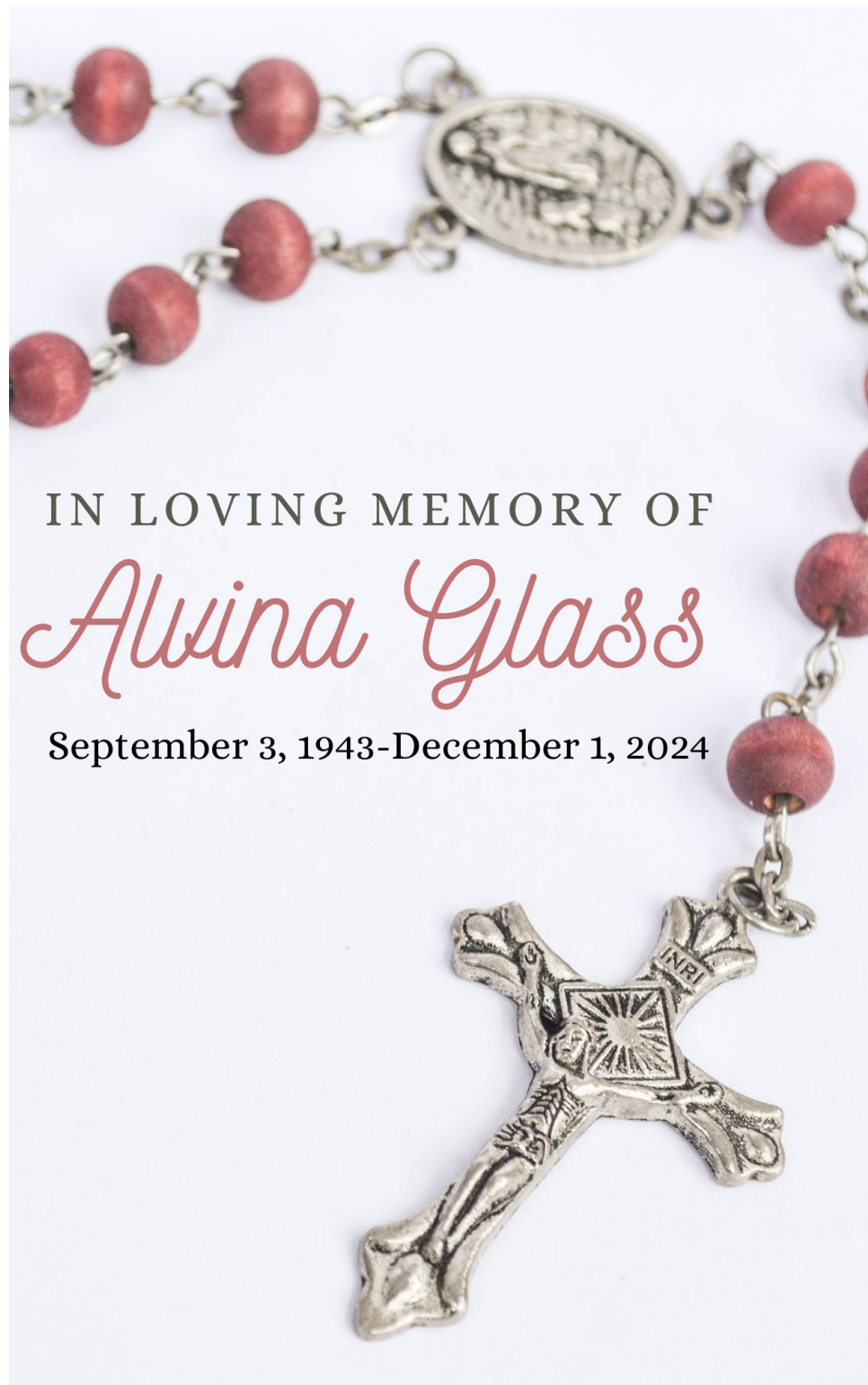
