The Church Believes

- ❖ In a personal God (Heb. 1:1-3).
- ❖ That salvation comes only through Jesus Christ (Acts 4:12), and that His death on the cross was God's supreme gift to man (John 3:16).
- ❖ That our Lord was raised from the dead (1 Cor. 15:20), and is in the heavenly sanctuary ministering as our High Priest (Heb 4:14).
- ❖ That the Holy Spirit is a member of the Godhead and is the divine Comforter (John 15:26).
- ❖ That the entire Bible which includes the Ten Commandments and the seventh-day Sabbath (Ex. 20:3-17), is the Word of God (2 Tim. 3:16).
- ❖ That we show our allegiance by keeping the seventh-day Sabbath, for Jesus said, "If ye love me, keep my commandments" (John 14:15).
- ❖ In the support of the Gospel through tithes and offerings (Lev. 27:30; Mal. 3:8-11; Matt. 23:23).
- ❖ In the gifts of the Spirit, including the Spirit of Prophecy (Eph. 4:8-11; Rev. 12:17; Rev. 19:10).
- ❖ That by nature, man is mortal (Job 4:17; 1 Tim. 6:15,16), and that the dead are in an unconscious state (Eccl. 9:5; John 11:11-14).
- ❖ That the wicked will not burn eternally, but will be burned up (Mal. 4:1-3).
- ❖ That our Savior Jesus Christ will soon return (John 14:1-3), then the dead in Christ will be raised and all God's people will be caught up together to meet Christ in the air (1 Thess. 4:15-18).
- ❖ In baptism by immersion (Mark 1:9,10; Rom. 6:3-5).
- ❖ In the ordinances of humility and the Lord's Supper (John 13:4-17; 1 Cor. 11:23-26).
- ❖ That righteousness comes by faith, not works (Rom. 4:3-5; Eph. 2:8,9).
- ❖ In discarding unhealthy practices, such as the use of intoxicants, tobacco, unclean meats, etc. (Pro. 23:29-32; 1 Cor. 3:16,17; Deut. 4:3-20; Isa. 66:15-17).
- ❖ That salvation is a "gift from God" and is not received through any merit of the sinner (Eph. 2:8).
- ❖ That Christ is able to keep us from falling and to present us faultless (Jude 24).
