Ricky leaves his memories to be cherished by family and friends.*



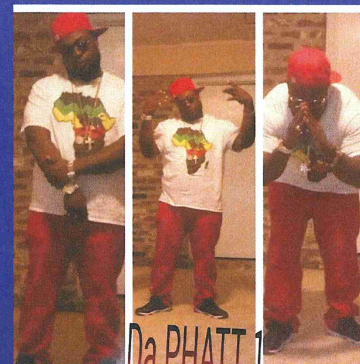
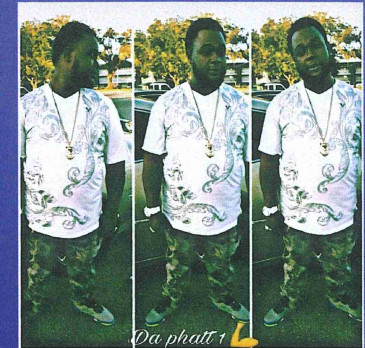
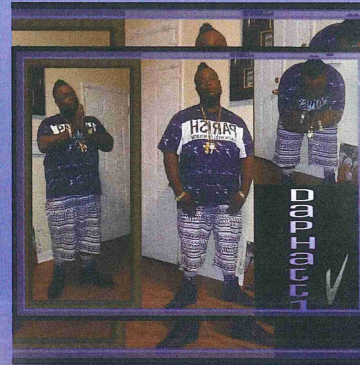


Broken Chain
