



Medication Administration Policy/Permission Slip

On occasion during the school year a child will need either a prescription medication such as an antibiotic, or an over-the-counter medication, such as Tylenol. The administration or faculty will not give medication to a student unless a permission slip and the appropriate medication for one day's dosage are turned in at the school office by the parent or guardian on the day the medication is to be administered. A student taking medication that has not been pre-approved or administered by a faculty or authorized staff member may be subject to possible discipline.
