To Qualify for SUFS:

❖ Maximum Gross Monthly Income

- Family of 2 \$2,456
- Family of 3 \$3,098

Add \$641 for each

- Students entering kindergarten must be 5 years old by September 1
- Students entering 1st grade must be 6 years old by September 1
- Students entering grades 6-12 must have attended a Florida public school for the entire August 2015-June 2016 school year

Application Information

Before you begin your application, please review the list below. If any of these apply to your family situation, please have the information available during the application process to help you answer the questions.

1. Pay stubs for all adults in the household. Be sure to include stubs for all jobs worked for the most recent month (past 30 days).
2. Unemployment or worker's compensation receipts for all adults in the household for the most recent month (past 30 days).
3. Social Security benefits letter for everyone in your household that receives benefits. Use the statement for the most recent month or benefit period. (This may be your yearly statement.)
4. Child support documents that show the amount actually received each month for all children in the household during the past year
5. The monthly total of financial assistance received by your household. This could include money received from the State of Florida (TANF), family members, friends, etc.
6. Accurate social security numbers for all household members.
7. Your 2014 tax return including all supporting schedules.
8. If you are self-employed, provide a profit and loss statement for the most current month.
9. Birth certificates for all children that are not currently enrolled in a school.
10. Report cards or transcripts for each student that is applying for SUFS for the 2015-2016 school year.
11. An application fee of \$29 per family payable by:
 - Credit Card
 - Debit Card
