Richard “Dick” Lee Neveau, 75, of Kewaunee, WI, passed away December 11, 2023, surrounded by family at Bellin Hospital in Green Bay. Richard was born on November 29, 1948, in Baraboo, WI, to the late Paul and Ethel (Hoefert) Neveau. He attended Preble High School, graduating in 1967. He went on to obtain a degree from Northeast Wisconsin Technical College in Auto Technology.

Richard met the love of his life, Nancy Shemenkowski in Kewaunee in 1983 and married her later that year on October 28th in Michigan. Together, Richard and Nancy raised 11 children. They also opened their hearts to foster children, caring for dozens of boys and girls in their home throughout the years.
