He was born on November 13, 1944 in Roosevelt, Utah to William Ira and Verda (Roberts) Blanchard.

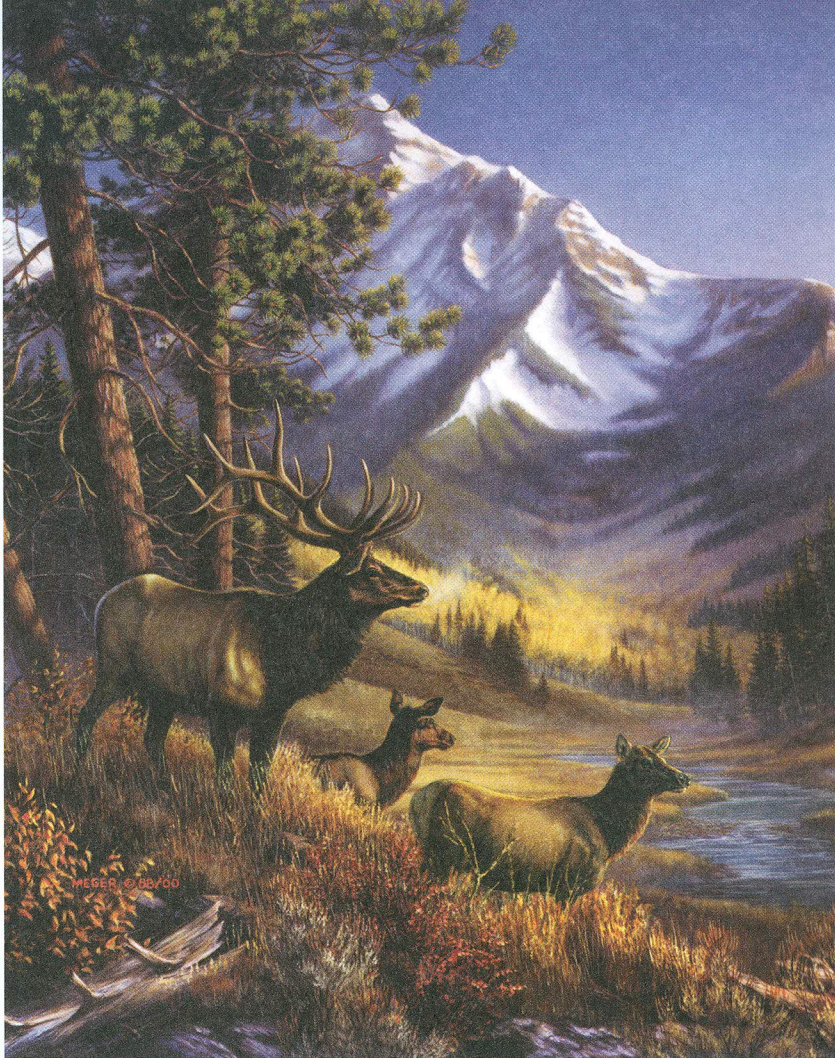
He married Barbara Bertling on June 12, 1989 in Vernal, Utah. They were married 28 years.
