*But we remember now in love,*

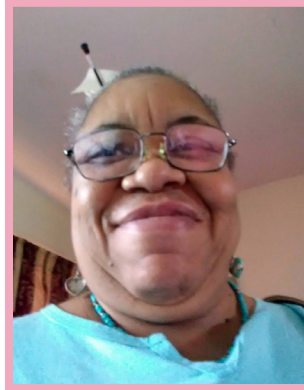
*Your life from start to end,*

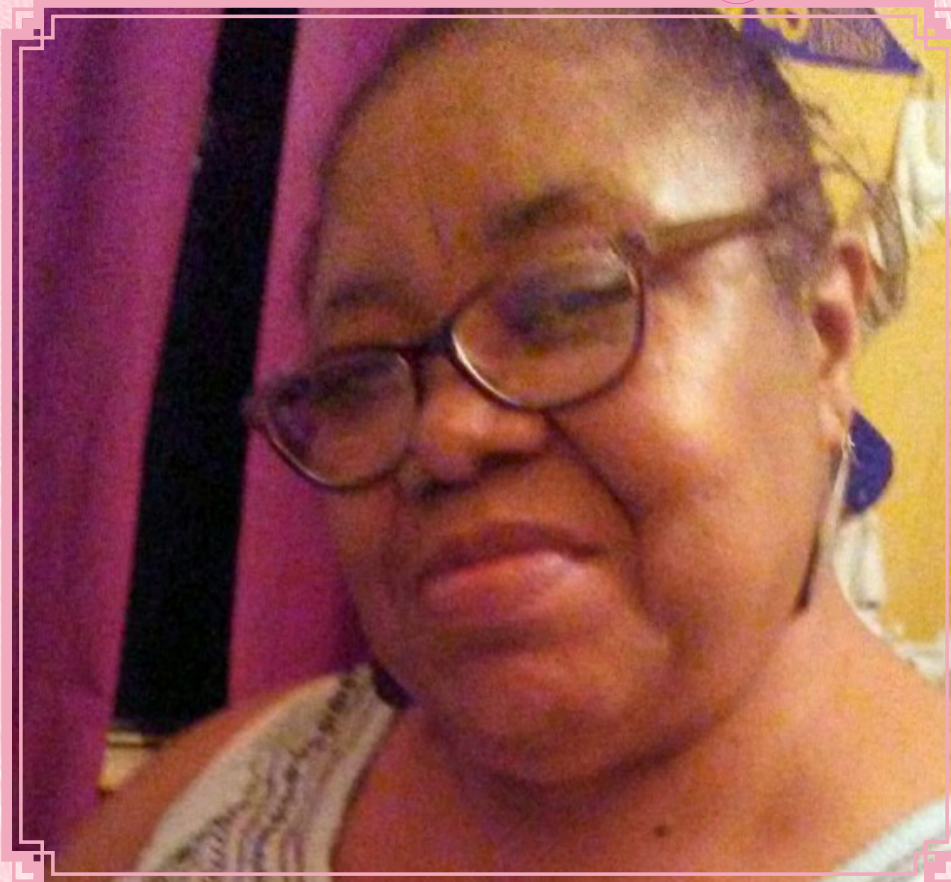
