Following school, Carolyn returned to Belleville where she started her nursing career at the Republic County Hospital, first as an acute care nurse before she transitioned to the Long Term Care Unit. Carolyn became the Director of Long Term Care, a position that she held for over 40 years. In November 1984, Carolyn married Dale Frankamp. They lived in Belleville and attended the Belleville Weslevan Church. Carolyn enjoyed her family, especially her grandchildren. She took her grandchildren on camping trips, to rodeos and horse shows. The grandchildren always enjoyed coming up to spend Saturday nights with Grandma and Grandpa, then having breakfast and a family dinner of chicken noodle soup on Sunday. Carolyn was preceded in death by her parents, her husband Wes, husband Dale, her sister Lynda LaClef, brother Bob Pugh, and granddaughter Shaylynn Lee Morey. 
