## 3. National Workshop – One Sport Structure Concept

Following the announcement by Sport Australia that all funded sports need to move to a 'One Sport' model or risk lose funding. SQA has prioritised discussion with the States on a collaborative way forward. Sport Australia's focus under the model is on achieving shared services, joint finances and direct line management of employees. The presentations around consumer centric thinking and the presentation by Triathlon Queensland in regards the progress they have made the past two years provided great insights in to the options in front of the sport. A date has been set aside for a Squash 'One Sport' Workshop. We hope 2-4 from each State is able to make the session.

The touch point will also provide us the opportunity to revisit the strategy at a national and state level.
