Their friendship grew, and lifelong best friends were married on November 20, 1957, at the First Reformed Church in Rock Valley, Iowa. They started their married life on the farm and had their first daughter, Leanne, in Edgerton, Minnesota. Don and Helen moved to a farm near Maurice, Iowa where he farmed some land, milked cows, and cared for chickens and pigs. While living near Maurice for four years their family grew with three sons, Darwin, Mike, and Herlan. In 1964 Don's dad, Henry,

retired from farming near Alvord, Iowa. Don and Helen moved to the "home place" and continued his passion of farming, and had their 5th child, Kyle.

Don enjoyed farming, while he did most of the milking, Helen was working alongside taking care of the chickens and running the household. In the earlier years of marriage, they enjoyed taking the kids fishing and visiting grandpa Henry in Minnesota.
