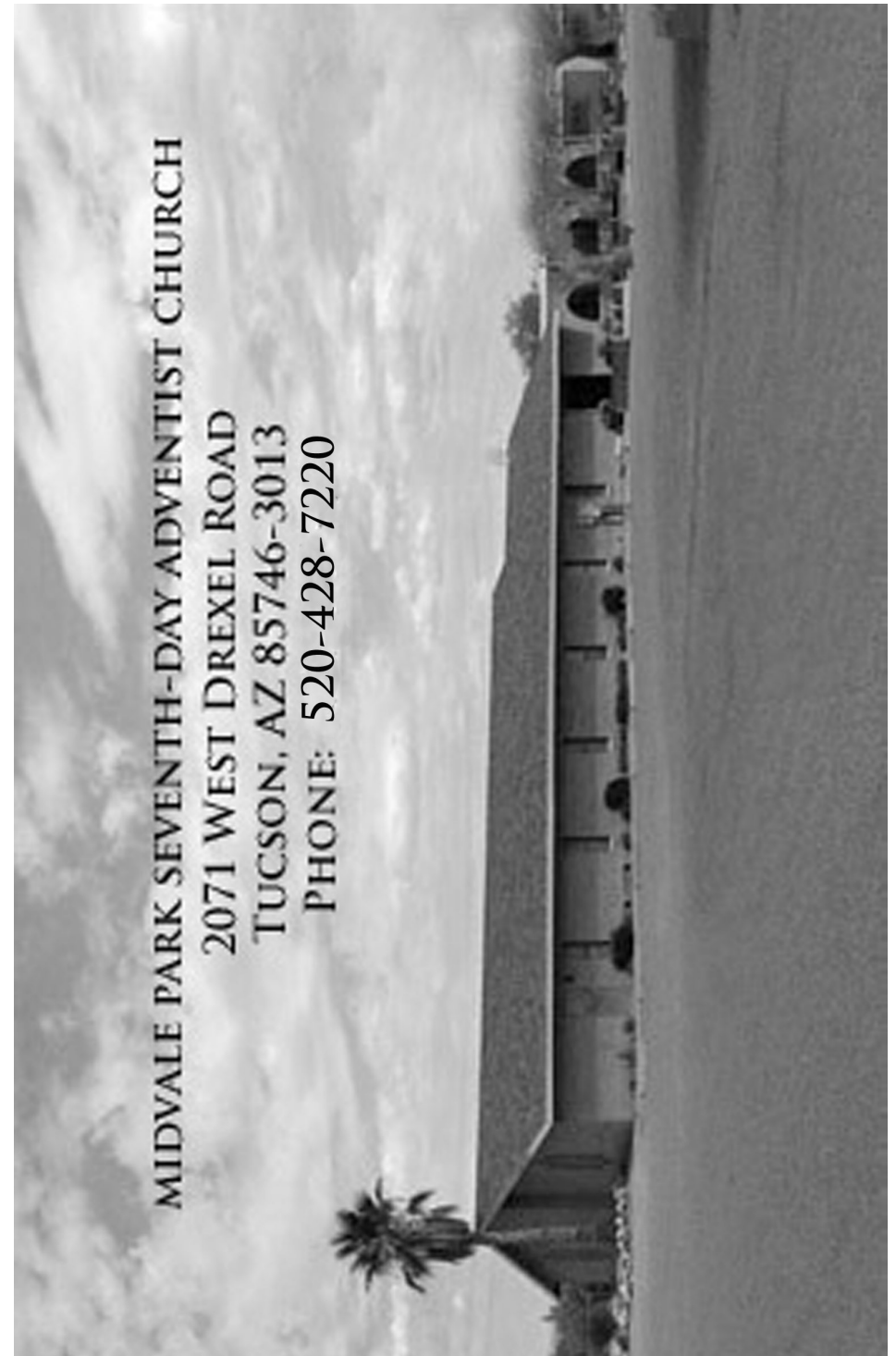
Kitchen:
