**Student Eligibility for School Activities and Financial Assistance** - Students must maintain eligibility requirements to participate in activity trips and receive financial assistance. Students with 2 Ds or 1 F, or have missing assignments one week prior to the event, will be ineligible to participate in off-campus activities, field trips and class trips and will be disqualified from financial assistance.
