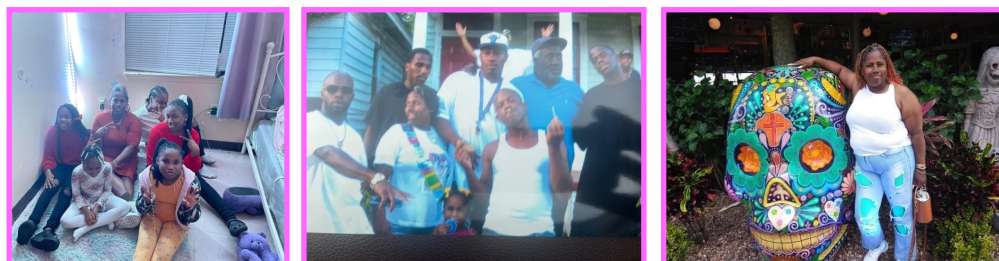
Obituary
