



### **Supplies for Infants and Children**

- Formula and bottles
- Powdered milk
- Comfort teddy bear
- Disposable diapers

### **For Each Member of the Household**

- One complete change of clothing
- Sturdy shoes(keep by bed)
- Rain poncho
- Warm cap and gloves
- Blanket or sleeping bag for each person

### **First Aid and Medical**

- Basic First Aid Book
- Basic first aid kit
- 7-10 days of any prescription medications
- Personal list of medications
- Denture needs
- Spare contact lenses and supplies
- Pair of extra eyeglasses
- Spare hearing aid batteries

### **Other**

- Pet food and extra water for pets
- Games, books, other entertainment, especially for children
- Cash, checks, credit cards, roll of quarters and dimes for pay phones
- Insurance policy numbers
- Name and number of insurance agent and doctors
- Out of state contact number and numbers of people you want to contact
- Photo identification (Old driver's license)

### **Storage of Supplies**

Store emergency supplies in one location that is cool, dark and safe (such as garage corner, closet, or under a bed). Use clean portable containers such as a garbage can on wheels, plastic tubs with lids or duffle bags. Replace stored food and water once a year.
