We are celebrating the first birthday in our classroom this school year with a very special 4<sup>th</sup> grader. We hope your birthday is wonderful in every way!

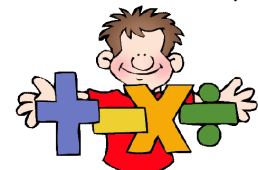

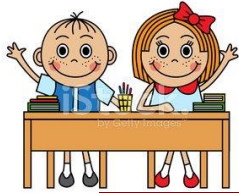
