Air-Dry Clay (small container)

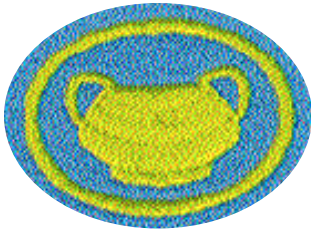
