An Intent for Re-Enrollment form for the 2021-2022 school year will need to be submitted by **March 1**. It will also need to be accompanied by a \$35/child or \$75/family minimum deposit which will be applied toward the \$250/child early registration fee with the balance due by June 15, 2021. This early deposit will lock families into the \$250 registration fee rate until June 15th. All families that register between March 2nd and July 1st will pay a \$300 registration fee. Families that register after July 1st will be charged a \$330 registration fee.

The spring 2021 Soccer Registration continues through February 10.

Don't forget that the online system allows you to pay online, keep track of your family "account" with the [SCSL](#), and easily re-register your players on a season-to-season basis.
