

International Students

Who is an international student? – Any student who attends CVA under a student visa. College View Academy is happy to admit students from outside the United States who meet the following requirements:

1. Must attend for at least one full year.
2. Students must be no younger than 15 and no older than 18 when they arrive.
3. When accepted, the student is expected to pay the tuition and fees up front for an academic year.
4. Students must be motivated and serious about their academics to take the school required courses.
5. Academic transcripts of the three last years of school translated in English must accompany the application.
6. Students must be personally mature enough to handle a year abroad.
7. Must prove financial ability to cover tuition and fees.
8. Students must be intermediate English speakers and have proof of one of these:

Slate	4.0
TOEFL Jr.	700
TOEFL iBT	30-40
TOEFL (computer based)	93-120
TOEFL (paper based)	397-433

Application Process:

Please print out from the website the packet of forms for international students. Fill out all forms and sent to the school, by fax or email. (A+ Global Education students should follow the specific instructions set up by that organization.) This packet must include:

- Application for admittance
- Internet usage contract
- Consent to treat and permission to go on the high school retreat
- Official transcripts for all high school level work done by the student.
- Proof of immunization, including a complete series of Hepatitis B, and a series of MMR
- Copy of passport
- Letter authorizing host family to keep the student in their home and be guardians for the school year
- Proof of medical insurance
- Proof of a physical examination in the last six months

Housing Policy:

We expect our international students to have a positive experience while attending CVA. To maximize their performance in school and in the English learning process, we ask that the student live in a supervised Christian environment. The following is required:

- The individual they live with is 25 years old or older and have obtained legal guardianship. (Copy of this document must be on file.)
- Host family must be approved by the school.
- Living arrangements must be made for the entire school year. Student may not be changing residence frequently while attending CVA, unless there are extenuating circumstances which need to be made known to the school.
- The financial arrangements for living expenses are between the host family and the student. The school doesn't have anything to do with this.
