I love you to the STARS and will greatly miss you!!

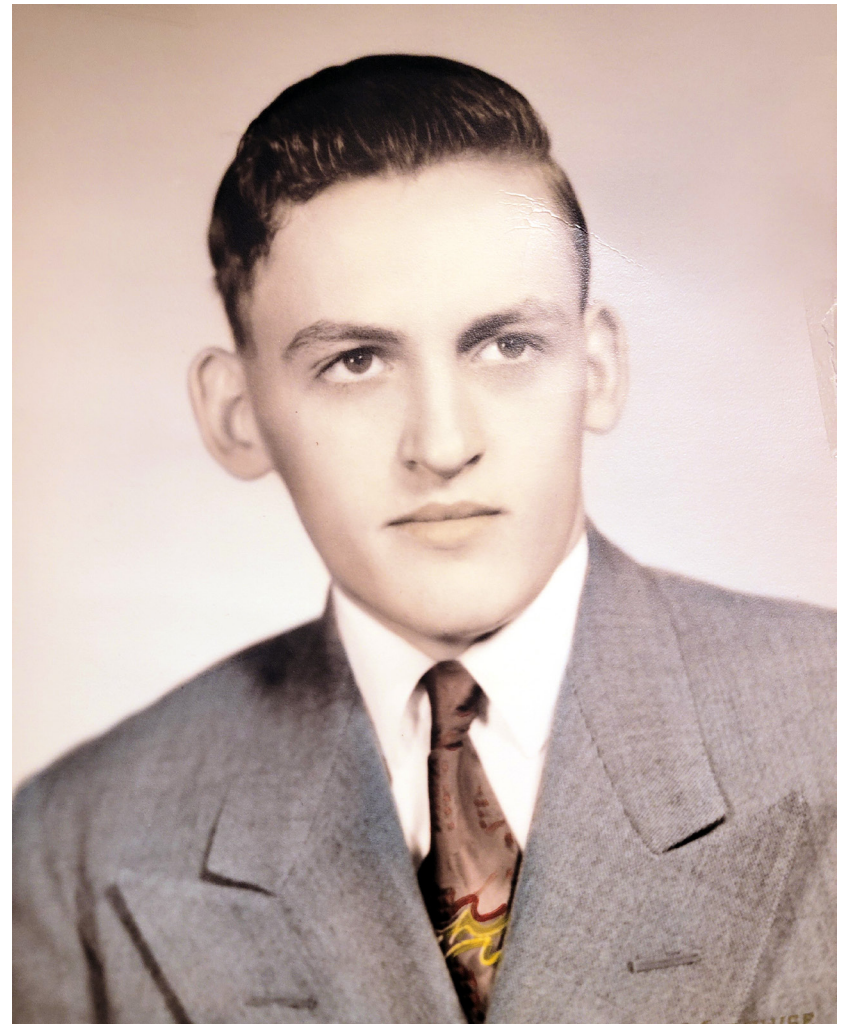
