# **Performance Development Coaching Course**

Squash Australia will be holding the first Performance Development Coaching Course from 9-14 December 2019 at Carrara Indoor Sporting Complex.

Performance Development course is designed to train coaches with a process of **HOW** to coach players to compete at a junior international level. It addresses the key issues of 'Knowledge and Understanding' and the 'Skills of Delivery' utilising the 'Tools' of how to coach players to apply pressure utilising the key skills of a **Perception & Decision** making approach.

### **Coach Accreditation**

Is your Squash Australia Coaching accreditation up to date?

To ensure that you are covered as a coach, you are required to have a valid coaching accreditation and be affiliated to their State/Territory Squash Association

Your coaches insurance is incorporated within the Squash Australia Personal Accident and Public Liability Professional Indemnity Insurance policy. Note that coaches are referred to as insured persons within these policies, and therefore receive the benefit of the insurance cover.

It is important to note that coaches who undertake private coaching are not covered through the club's insurance and would need separate coaching insurance. This is covered under their coach accreditation with Squash Australia. This means that any coach that is affiliated (through their State/Territory Squash Association) and a currently accredited coach is covered for private coaching under the Coaches Insurance policy.
