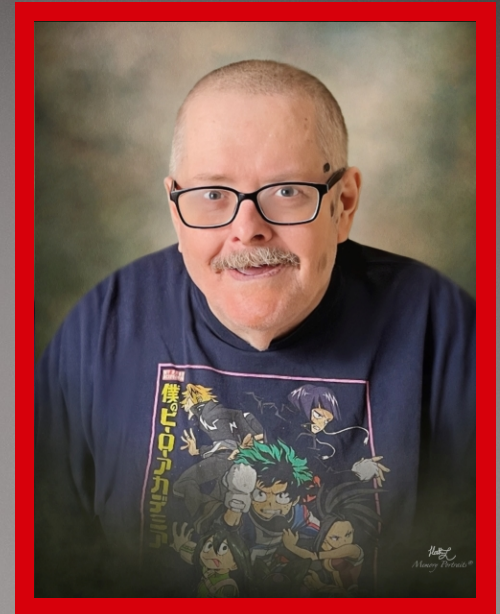


If I could write from *Heaven*
