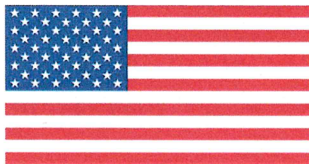
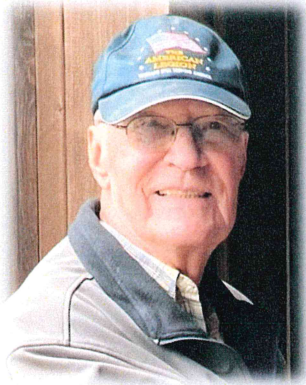


**REMEMBERING THE LIFE OF
