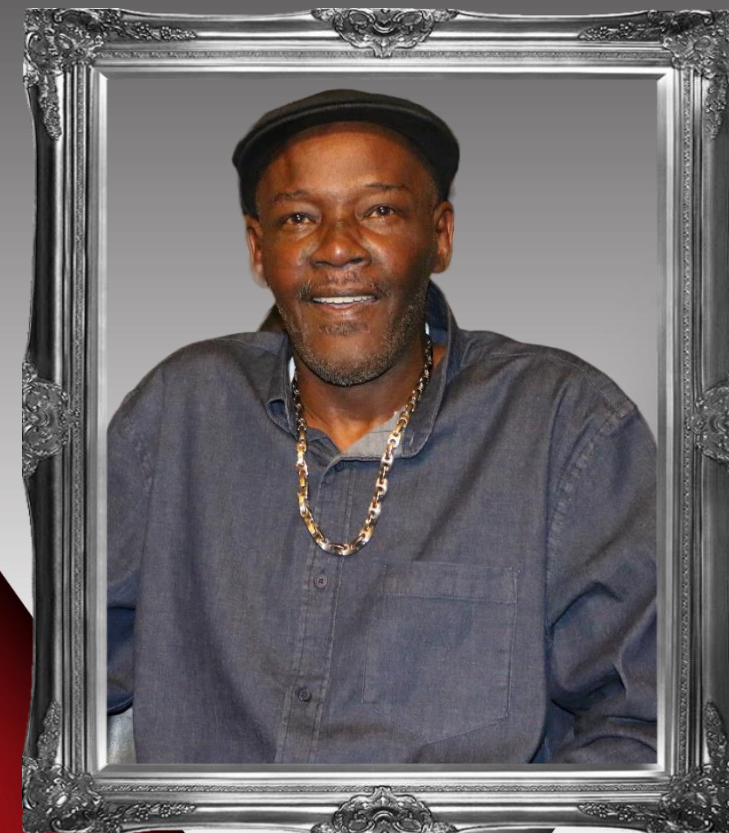

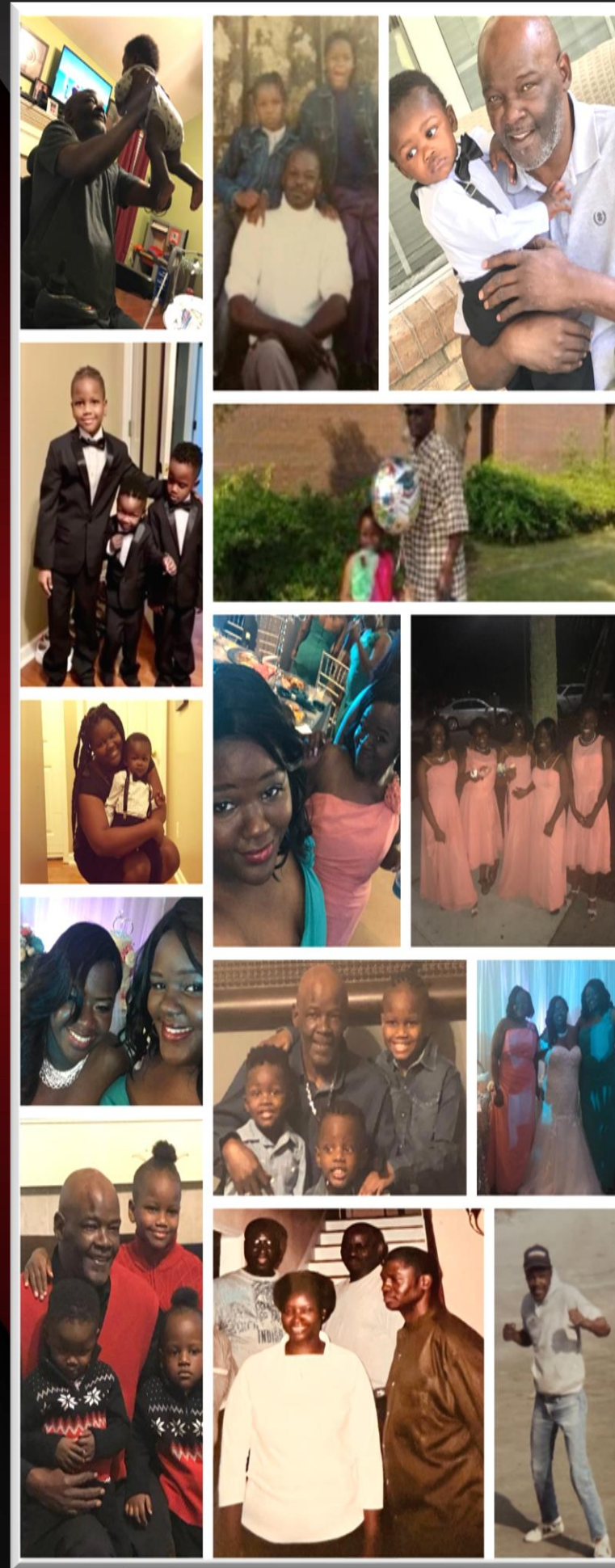
# LIFE REFLECTION
