About the bulletin cover and monitor's picture. Ice discs, ice circles, ice pans, or ice crepes are an unusual natural phenomenon. Ice disks occur in slowly moving water in cold climates and can vary in size, with circles more than 49 ft in diameter being observed. An ice circle, approximately 298 feet in

diameter, appeared in Westbrook, Maine in January 2019. Our ice disc photograph being shown today was photographed on Tuesday, February 12, on the Whitefish Stage Rd. bridge over the Stillwater River. It may still be there today! Be careful on the bridge, there are no sidewalks. The disc is on the east side. This will get you close. 48°12'37.19"N - 114°18'25.65"W (Google Earth Pro) Caution: Homeless camp *under* north bridge abutment. Photograph was taken *on* bridge, standing in northbound lane.
