

School Tools for 2018-2019

4-5 composition notebooks (NOT spiral bound)	5th-8th graders should get college-ruled notebooks.
3 two-pocket folders WITH prongs	These can be plain or fancy, paper or plastic.
3-5 two-pocket folders WITHOUT prongs	These can be plain or fancy, paper or plastic, they can be punched with three holes or not.
4+ fine point, low-odor , dry erase markers - you only need one at a time	Older students may appreciate the extra-fine point markers that Expo makes. This is one product where I recommend any brand EXCEPT Crayola. Their dry-erase products don't erase well.
Set of colored pencils (at least 10, more is better)	You are welcome to bring markers and crayons, but all students should have colored pencils.
A hand-held pencil sharpener	This should have something to catch shavings. Your colored pencils will need it. NO electric or battery-powered, please.
Liquid glue or gluesticks	These will be used throughout the year, but are usually cheapest this time of year.
Scissors, eraser	
2 Black, fine point permanent markers (Sharpies preferred)	These will be labeled and kept for use during art class and other specific times, not kept in student desks.
Ruler	Should have inches and centimeters
Bible	Pick a version you like to read and can understand. This will be our textbook for Bible class.
Pencils (and pens for upper graders)	Upper-graders may use a pen for most classes, but will need pencils for math. Students seemed to lose/use these up rapidly last year. You may want to keep a stash at home to send in regularly.
Pencil bag or pouch, zippered	Please do NOT bring a pencil box. A zippered pouch or bag is what you need. You may want a 2 nd one for your colored pencils or markers.
6 th - 8 th only - calculator	NOT a scientific one, just a simple one that will add, subtract, multiply, and divide. They will be allowed to use it on some math assignments.
Loose leaf notebook paper	college-ruled, please, we have plenty wide-ruled
Headphones/earphones NOT earbuds	These are for use with our computers and ipads. They are to be left at school during the school year. THIS IS NOT OPTIONAL
Backpack or Book-bag	This doesn't need to be large, but it should be brought daily.

Optional Room Supplies. We will use and appreciate these if you can donate them.

- Disinfecting wipes (Clorox, Lysol, generic)
- Kleenex (especially if you know your child tends to have seasonal allergies)
- Colored copy paper (a single color pack is more useful)
