From Pastor's Desk

The scripture for today **Ezra 8:23**

"So we fasted and besought our God for this: and He answered our prayer."

Ezra, who was a direct descendant of Aaron the first High Priest, is granted permission to return to Jerusalem by the king of Persia. It took Ezra a full four months to complete his journey from Babylon to Jerusalem. Traveling in those times was extremely dangerous, especially for a group carrying gold, silver, and other valuables as they were. They were taking these valuables to Jerusalem for the house of God. Ezra realized the danger of his situation, but he had represented God as an all-powerful protector and, as a result, he said, "For I was ashamed to ask of the king a band of soldiers and horsemen to help us against the enemy in the way: because we had spoken unto the king, saying, The hand of our God is upon all them for good that seek him; but his power and his wrath is against all them that forsake him." *Ezra 8:22* Out of recognition of his need he called a time of fasting and prayer. God went with this group of faithful servants and, through their long journey, surrounded by enemies who could do them harm, God protected them and brought them home safely. When we put our trust in God, He never disappoints. When our lives are surrendered to Him, our destinies are secure. The power of prayer belongs to the children of God, and He is never out of reach of His children. No sincere prayer is without power or consequence. It remains in the heart of God and out of His heart the answers flow; our needs are met and God is glorified.
