

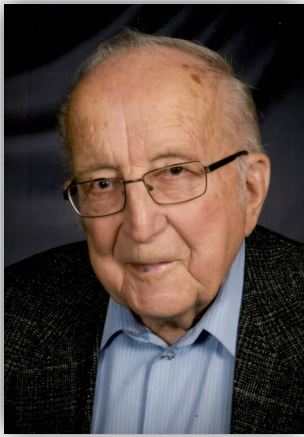


### *Safely Home*

William "Bill" Bullinger, 92, of Mandan, passed away January 22, 2019 at Sunset – a prospera Community, Mandan.
