ACCREDITATION. Fuller Theological Seminary is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges. The Schools of Theology and Intercultural Studies are also accredited by the Association of Theological Schools. The PhD and PsyD programs in clinical psychology of the School of Psychology are accredited by the American Psychological Association.

CALENDAR. Fuller operates on the quarter system, with three 11-week quarters (Fall, Winter, and Spring) and a 13-week Summer quarter. Degrees are granted and recorded every quarter. Since Fall 2007, the DMiss program has used a different calendar. See www.fuller.edu/registrar/transcriptkey for details.

CREDIT. The current measure of credit is the quarter hour. Prior to Fall 1950, the unit of credit was a semester hour. Prior to Fall quarter 1974, courses in the School of Intercultural Studies earned three quarter units of credit, but should be considered equivalent to four-unit courses. Cumulative totals reflect this equivalence.
